



## LIMITED WARRANTY

Yesteryear's Vintage Doors & Millwork, LLC. ("Company") warrants to the original purchaser of the Company's doors subject to the terms of the limited warranty as set forth below that the doors will be free of defects in materials and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the original date of purchase. This warranty excludes the glass, decorative elements, hardware, and architectural detail that may be attached to the door. All shipping & labor charges, including repair or replacement, labor (painting and transportation) are excluded and will be the responsibility of the owner. The Company's doors are not suitable for commercial use. The Company's doors are sold for residential use only. Commercial use of the doors voids this warranty. Doors 42" wide (or larger) must be 2 ¼" thick to be covered under warranty.

## SPECIAL FINISHING AND INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

The Company's doors are hardwood doors that require special finishing. Failure to finish the doors in accordance with the Finish Instructions voids this warranty. The Finishing Instructions are as follows:

**Prior to installation** - the door sections must be primed and painted or sealed on both sides and on all four edges with one(1) cost of exterior grade primer (or stain), and two (2) costs of high quality exterior grade paint or sealer applied in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

All doors must be finished in this manner within two (2) weeks from the date of shipment. Failure to install the doors in a workmanlike manner within two (2) weeks from the date of shipment shall void this warranty.

Doors that are finished on the exterior surface with dark, sun absorbing paints (*Ex. black, dark blue, dark brown, dark red*) will not be covered under warranty. These colors can induce the cracking, warping and excessive deterioration of solid wood products.

All exterior doors with applied moldings **must** be silicone sealed around the edged of moldings after finishing, to repel water from entering under or in between these areas. This will not effect the finish of the door, but is critical in sealing the joints.

Damage caused by the failure to appropriately finish the doors is excluded from this warranty. Note due to the differences in natural wood characteristics, the uniformity of wood selection color and grain is not warranted.

Doors must be installed to avoid excessive exposure to sun or moisture. It is the owner's obligation to periodically inspect the door finish. If the finish becomes weathered, deteriorated, or thin, then the affected surfaces must be stripped and refinished consistent with the Finish Instructions. Damaged caused by failure to do so is excluded from this warranty.

## INSTALLATION EXCLUSION

The Company does not install the doors and does not warrant installation. Improper installation may cause stress and cracks in the door. The Company may, at its discretion, deny warranty coverage of a door that exhibits stress or cracks caused by improper installation. The warranty excludes all doors that are not installed in a workman like manner.

This warranty does not apply to any door which has been damaged or has deteriorated due to misuse, accident, improper finishing, improper installation or failure to provide necessary maintenance.

## NO ASSIGNMENT

This warranty extends to the original purchaser of the door and cannot be transferred or assigned. Any attempt to transfer or assign the warranty shall void the warranty.

THERE IS NO WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR ANY OTHER IMPLIED WARRANTY BEYOND THE TWO-YEAR PERIOD DESCRIBED ABOVE. THE COMPANY WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OR FOR ANY FUTURE LOSS, WHICH MAY ARISE IN CONNECTION WITH ANY CLAIM.

The Company has not established any informal dispute settlement procedure of the type described in the Magnuson-Moss Warranty Act. Claims under this warranty must be made in writing promptly after discovery within the warranty period to the Company at the following address:

Proof of Purchase must be enclosed with the original claim. The Company reserves the right to request additional information regarding the claim and a photograph of the defective door.

In the event a door fails as a result of a defect in manufacturing, materials or workmanship within the limited warranty period, the Company, at its exclusive option, will: (1) complete the required repairs to the door in the Company factory; (2) replace or exchange the door; or (3) refund the original purchase price to the original purchaser. Such replacement or repairs do not include the necessary Finish of the doors which is the responsibility of the owner. The repair or replacement is warranted for the remainder of the original limited warranty period. The owner bears the cost of shipment and risk of loss of the damaged door shipped to the Company for evaluation. The Company is not responsible for providing temporary coverage of the door frame during the period of repair. This limited warranty does not extend to the use of this product under abnormal conditions or under conditions not reasonably foreseeable to, or beyond the control of the Company or the original owner. The original owner assumes all risk of any such use.

This warranty gives you specific legal right, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts and some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.
